Add's Roof Project

As many of you are aware we have been helping add and her 2 adopted daughters for over two years now.

The roof on the original building was falling down and the timber had almost been completely consumed by termites.

SHE purchased the materials required to replace the roof from generous donations and we removed the roof just in time before it collapsed onto the families head.



There was a visiting DTS team staying with us from YWAM Montana and they provided the muscle and we were able to remove the old structure and replace it with treated timber 4"x2" rafters and 2"x2" cross battens with corrugated cement sheeting in one day.

The following day we employed a local bricklayer to put a layer of bricks on top of the existing walls and seal the joint between the walls and the new roof and the last job was to refit the ceiling lights and install guttering to take all the rain water away from the house.



Also while half of the team from YWAM worked on the roof the others attacked the very over grown garden, a project we have worked on a few times since with different teams.

This was a great little project which made a huge difference to the family now they have a safe roof with no leaks or munching sounds and dust from the termites.
